

## INFORMATION CLAUSE PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 THE GDPR

In connection with the entry into force on 25 May 2018 of the GDPR, i.e. Regulation of the European Parliament and Council R2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data repealing the Directive 95/46/EC (general regulation on data protection) – we hereby inform you about the processing of your personal data on the terms set out below:

### 1. CONTROLLER

The Controller of your personal data, i.e. the entity making a decision for what purpose and to what extent these data are processed, is Piotr Głydziak, running JUSTART, ul. Pomorska 388, 91-001 Łódź, NIP /Tax Identification Number/: 7282553729, REGON /Business Identification Number/.

### 2. LEGAL BASIS FOR DATA PROCESSING

The legal basis for the processing of personal data provided by you shall be:

- Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR, which allows the processing of personal data if it is necessary in order to take steps to conclude and perform the agreement,
- Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR, which allows the processing of personal data if it is necessary to satisfy the legal obligations incumbent on the Controller, in particular, public service obligations, including accounting and tax obligations,
- Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR which allows the processing of personal data if it is necessary for purposes arising from legitimate interests pursued by the Controller or by a third party, in particular handling, investigation and defense against any claims related to the Agreement, as well as marketing, including direct marketing.

### 4. TRANSMISSION OF DATA TO INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS OR THIRD COUNTRIES

Personal data will not be transferred to international organizations or third countries understood as countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

### 5. DATA RECIPIENTS

Your personal data may be disclosed by the Controller to recipients, i.e. entities cooperating with the Controller, on the basis of agreements concluded by the Controller, in accordance with the applicable law. In particular, personal data may be disclosed to entities which provide the Controller with accounting, legal, or insurance services, as well as entities participating in the conclusion of agreements and the provision of services to you.

### 6. THE PERIOD AND OBJECTIVES OF DATA PROCESSING

The personal data provided by you will be processed, including storing, for the term of the agreement, as well as following its completion:

- for purposes resulting from legally justified interests carried out by the Controller, which means in particular handling, investigation, and defense against any claims related to the agreement,
- for purposes of satisfying legal obligations incumbent on the Controller, in particular accounting and tax obligations,
- for statistical purposes.

We will process your personal data, including storage, for marketing purposes, for the term of the agreement or until you submit your objection to such processing, whichever is earlier.

## 7. INSTRUCTIONS ABOUT THE RIGHTS

In connection with the processing of personal data by the Controller, you have the right to request from the Controller access to the data provided, the right to request its rectification, modification, or deletion, as well as the right to request the Controller to process your personal data and to transfer it.

In addition, you have the right to object at any time in the following situations:

- to the processing of personal data, to the extent that they are processed by the Controller for the purposes of direct marketing,
- to the processing of personal data, which takes place on the basis of the legally justified interest of the Controller or for statistical purposes, if such objection is justified by the specific situation in which you have found yourself.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection in Poland.

## 8. OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE DATA

We require you to provide personal data which is necessary for the conclusion and performance of the agreement, and which guarantees the protection of legitimate interests of the Controller, in particular for accounting and tax reasons and for handling, investigation, and defense against any claims related to the agreement. If for some reason you do not provide such personal data, we will not be able to conclude an agreement with you or take steps to perform it. In addition to the abovementioned cases, providing personal data is voluntary.

## 9. AUTOMATED DATA PROCESSING

The data provided by you will not be processed in an automated way, including in the form of profiling.

## 8. DATA PROTECTION

The Controller has taken all endeavours to ensure physical, technical, and organizational protection of personal data against its accidental or deliberate destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure, use, or access in accordance with applicable law.
